Payment:-

You can pay for the Summer School by two ways:-

1. By bank transfer

When paying by bank transfer you should transfer to the **NI Region of u3a** bank account with Santander Bank

The SS is important as it differentiates your payment from other payments into the account, and the SS stands for Summer School.

Cancellation

Cancellation with full refund can be made up to and including **Monday, 29th May**. Substitution may be possible after that date.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be allocated in two of the Student Village Lodges (see campus map) and in the Boyd Hall of Residence in the Conference Centre. Every attempt will be made to accommodate people close to friends but this cannot be guaranteed. The earliest bookings will be given first choice. All rooms are single, en-suite. There are no double rooms. Rooms in the lodges are ground floor, those in the Boyd Hall of Residence are upstairs. **Please note: Towels are not provided.**

Bedroom accommodation is available from **13.00 hrs** on the day of arrival and must be vacated by **09.30 hrs** on the day of departure. Storage for bags can be arranged.

Catering

Morning and afternoon tea/coffee breaks are included in the school package, as is dinner on Tuesday evening (main course, dessert & tea/coffee) **but you are asked to pay individually for your breakfast and lunches in the Manor Restaurant.**

The two lodges each have a kitchen with facilities. Snacks and a limited selection of drinks can be purchased in the Cyber café. Drinks will be provided in the pre-dinner reception only, so you may want to bring your own for the Conference Dinner and the Jazz Night entertainment.

Accommodation on Tuesday 13th June

For those who wish to stay at Greenmount on Tuesday 13th before the summer school opens on Wednesday 14th June, no catering will be available that evening. However there are catering facilities in the lodges and tea, coffee, sugar, milk and biscuits will be provided. You may want to bring your own snacks.

The Manor Restaurant will be open for breakfast from 7.30am for those staying overnight on Tuesday 13th June.

Transport

Taxi: Greenmount College is within easy distance of Antrim bus and rail station. If you give notice of likely arrival time, a taxi can be ordered for you and possible sharers notified.

Driving: The entrance to Greenmount is around 3 miles from Antrim town off the Dublin Road out of Antrim. You are advised to park in the visitors' car park, then enter via the Resource Centre.

There are a number of car parks if you keep driving along the entrance road you'll come to the visitor's car park on your right and the Reception building/Resource Centre is directly ahead and clearly marked. Registration will be in the foyer.

Safety

You are asked to note the safety instructions which are posted in each classroom and in each bedroom. These notices provide information on assembly points in the event of an emergency evacuation.
